Manderson, WY, Police Department is seeking a full-time police officer for the town. Duties will include patrolling the town and enforcing state laws and local ordinances.

We are a small, professional department with a focus on community-oriented policing. We enforce state statutes and local ordinances with integrity and maintain high standards of conduct.

Manderson is located at the base of the Bighorn Mountains, a short drive from Yellowstone National Park and with access to fishing and recreation on the Bighorn River.

Basic qualifications include:

- 21 or older
- High school diploma or GED
- No criminal history and clean driving record
- Completion of full background check

Certification is preferred but not required. If not certified, MPD will pay for attendance at the Wyoming State Law Enforcement Academy, including wages and expenses to and from Douglas.

Compensation includes salary (DOE); participation in the Wyoming State LE Retirement System; medical/dental/vision insurance (100% paid for employee; family insurance available at employee's cost), and paid time off. Ongoing training is available.
